The United Republic of Tanzania *has received* financing in the amount of US\$ 25 million equivalents from the World Bank toward the cost of the Tanzania Maternal and Child Health Investment Program (TMCHIP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works and consulting services to be procured under this project.

The project will include the following components:

- (a) Strengthen the provision of RMNCAH-N services; and
- (b) Enhance Institutional Capacity to Manage Project Supported Activities.

6.	Technical Assistant to assist project Environmental matters
7.	Technical Assistant for Social safeguards.
8.	Technical Assistant to assist with project Procurement matters.
9.	Individual Consultant to conduct EIA and RAP.
10.	Individual Consultant to Conduct a mid-term review of the project.
